### Meeting Chair - President Davenport

### I. Information Items

- A. Review of Notes
  - No changes noted. If changes are needed they can be recommended by the MSUAASF President.
- B. MSU President's Report (R. Davenport)
  - December 11 is the President's Chili Luncheon from 11:30am-1pm.
  - D. Jones will be participating in Dancing with the Stars to represent Minnesota State, Mankato's 150<sup>th</sup> year. He will be partnered with Emily Navara who is an MNSU student and an elementary education major.
  - Commencement will take place this Saturday 12/9/17 until 1pm.
  - The leadership council meeting took place 12/4/17-12/5/17. The council discussed the climate studies on campus, student success, and diversity plans so that campuses could share their experiences and ideas.
  - The collaboration funding grant applications are due by Friday 12/9/17 to the system office. MNSU is submitting four proposals for review. The collaboration funding grant is using money off of the top of the appropriations (5 million dollars) to encourage innovative partnerships. Schools must have partner institutions to be eligible for the grant.
  - The system office is taking a strong stance on online learning. MNSU is on the front lines of online learning in the Minnesota State System.
  - Minnesota State currently has a 1.4 million budget for marketing and advertising. The current billboard campaign has received negative feedback because it highlights that we are the lowest cost opportunity for students but it does not highlight the high quality of education we provide.
  - The leadership council also discussed advising. These conversations solidified that MNSU's move to go forward with our advising initiatives were the right thing to do, even though they were controversial.
  - The regional HR center was also discussed. S. Appelquist will be the interim HR director after M. Carlson steps down. S. Barrett will be talking with S. Appelquist for how to make the service centers more effective. S. Appelquist seemed open to ideas, stay tuned for more information at future meetings. The Board of Trustees is behind the centralized HR model so we need to make it work as much as possible. S. Barrett also added that there will need to be appropriate audits and evaluations of the effectiveness of the regional HR center.

- C. MSUAASF President's Report (S. Granberg-Rademacker)
  - MSUAASF members are currently busy with closing the residence halls for Winter Break, meeting with prospective students, resolving student cases, and the commencement ceremony.
  - Our leadership team is working on membership, constitution updates, and our upcoming elections this spring.
  - At the MSUAASF state Meet & Confer the focus was on student success, enrollment and retention, reaching out to disadvantaged student populations, and the re-classification of MSUAASF positions.
  - S. Granberg-Rademacker asked M. Wells for an update on the feedback received via the listening sessions regarding the recent leadership changes. M. Wells answered that there were four listening sessions hosting nearly 100 participants. All six academic colleges, support staff, and most graduate programs were represented. M. Wells also received electronic communications of feedback from individuals who couldn't make it to the sessions or individuals who had further feedback after the sessions concluded.
  - Some of the feedback that M. Wells received so far has been regarding:
    - 1. Continuing the conversations
    - 2. Funding concerns
    - 3. Graduate assistantships not being competitive which loses the University some of the best applicants
    - 4. Pursuing private giving and endowment
    - 5. Connecting with alumni of graduate programs
    - 6. Increasing support structures
    - 7. Incentivizing faculty engagement
    - 8. Increasing graduate research
    - 9. Research compliance
    - 10. The graduate student experience
    - 11. Building community for graduate students
    - 12. Re-evaluating fees
    - 13. Focusing on diversity
    - 14. Increasing marketing
    - 15. Addressing graduate class quality and rigor
  - S. Granberg-Rademacker asked what the timeline would be for addressing the feedback received. M. Wells stated that she is currently reviewing and synthesizing the input and that the listening sessions will continue. M. Wells would like to continue to have graduate student and faculty engagement in this conversation.
  - M. Wells also mentioned that 3 faculty, 2 professional staff, and 2 administrators were sent to a graduate conference in Scotsdale, AZ. M. Wells met with the group before they departed to discuss goals for the meeting. They will meet again once the group returns to share information received.
- D. Vice President Student Affairs & Enrollment Management Report (D. Jones)
  - We are currently down 295 headcount for spring. This number is expected since we were down 200 FYE from fall. The new student intention to enroll for spring is flat and there is no anticipation that this will change.
  - Fall 2018 applications are up .3% overall. Intent to enroll is up 17.4% from one year ago and 7% from 2 years ago. Transfer students intent to enroll is up 20% from last year. While these projections are early, D. Jones hopes they maintain.
  - S. Granberg-Rademacker asked if enrollment confirmation spikes and then changes later. D. Jones answered that enrollment confirmation has been relatively consistent with a 91-92%

accuracy rating. J. Van Boxel asked if there has been an enrollment effect on international students due to the travel ban. D. Jones answered that they are anticipating a national effect on international enrollment. D. Jones stated that while MNSU only has 7 students from the countries affected by the travel ban, it could have rippling repercussions. International student's submission of their I20 forms in the spring will the best indicator for fall international enrollment.

- St. Cloud currently has over 200 more international students than we have, which is surprising since we have over 1000 students more than St. Cloud does.
- R. Davenport stated we recently ranked fourth in state university rankings after the University of Minnesota, St. Cloud State, and St. Thomas.
- The admissions office has been overwhelmed with the large requests for tours.
- H. Morris added that they forecasted for over 2500 diverse high school students to visit MNSU this year and so far 2000 have visited as of October. This high number is promising since students of color are large drivers of enrollment.

### II. Discussion Items

### A. Budget (R. Straka)

- There is a funding deficit of 188 million, when you factor in legislative funding that number becomes 300 million dollars.
- There is a 700 million dollar deficit projected in 2020-2021.
- These numbers include anticipated revenue increases but not increased inflation, which means that the 2020-2021 deficit will likely be closer to 1 billion dollars.
- The governor wants to wait until March for special session due to the uncertainty of the federal tax package and stimulus.
- We are in a cash positive year. There will be a decrease in appropriations next year. There will also be a freeze of undergraduate tuition for next year.
- There have been significant salary savings in the last years and we continue to trend that way. R. Straka suggests using the reserve and not making reductions based on fuzzy forecasts depending on how much in salary savings the university has.
- Our University reserve is currently almost up to the system level max.
- Since there are so many budget unknowns right now, R. Straka suggests using the reserve to get us to next fall and see where we are at. This will also be at end of the strategic budget cycle which will allow us to better allocate our resources.

### B. HR Topics (S. Barrett)

- Human Resource Vacancies
  - o The two attached lists are sorted by the status in the search process and by the bargaining unit. Please let S. Barrett know if anything needs to be cleaned up.
- Human Resources Investigation Process
  - o The attachment outlines the investigation timeline. HR's goal is to get the investigation timeline to 30 days. The investigation timeline average is currently between 10 and 11 days for new cases within the new framework.
  - o We will receive a status report from HR every month so that we can monitor the timeline.
  - o Clean up for inquiries that happened before the new framework is still ongoing.

### FLSA

- o Handout provided
- o HR has audited over 100 positions. So far the system office has returned 1/3 of those positions. We have not received a decision on 53 of the positions that have been sent to the system office.
- o The system office has agreed to apply the Academic Administrative Exemption duties test framework to the Academic Advisor positions. These position reviews will likely be received back within the next week.
- o M. Iverson asked if all advising positions were being evaluated, even the ones that already came back. S. Barrett answered yes.
- o S. Barrett stated that we haven't got any position reviews back from the system office since August.
- o H. Morris asked how many positions were reclassified out of the 33 positions returned. S. Barrett is going to look and report back. S. Granberg-Rademacker stated that it is close to 100%.
- Holiday Calendar 2018-2019
  - o Handout provided.
  - o The 2018-2019 winter holidays fall on Tuesdays. MSUAASF will celebrate Veterans Day and President's Day during that week.
  - o The 2019-2020 holidays falls on Wednesdays. This presents more options for when Veteran's Day and President's Day could be celebrated. S. Barrett is interested in members' feedback on the 2019-2020 holiday schedule. He hopes that the final decision will be by February at the latest.
  - o S. Barrett hopes that all employee groups will reach consensus on when holidays will be celebrated, but that it is not necessary for a consensus to be reached.
  - o J. Clarke mentioned that we have polled members regarding their preferences in the past. R. Straka also added that there used to be a calendar committee. S. Granberg-Rademacker stated that we will have a calendar plan by the next meet and confer.
- Professional Excellence Award
  - o Details emailed to members on 12/7/17.
- Professional Development Day
  - o Takes place on Monday, December 11th
  - o Coincides with the President's Chili luncheon.
  - S. Barrett will be hosting a session on FLSA.

### C. Death of a Student Protocol (D. Jones)

- MNSU has a rich history of being caring when a student passes away.
- This past fall was unusual with 3 students passing away in a car accident.
- The protocol is documentation of what we do across all departments when a student passes away so future colleagues will have a resource to lean on when tragedy happens.
- The protocol is an organic document that will change over time, since we will learn more of what needs to be done with each passing.
- This internal document will be located in the student affairs website under faculty and staff resources.

• This procedure is meant to be a resource for us. No feedback is requested at this time since it will be revised as needed.

### D. Scholarship Processes Update (K. Stanley)

- This is a four and a half year project that started in 2014. K. Clark and D. Jones started combatting the challenge of getting private support scholarships to the students in need of funds.
- The University purchased Scholarship Finder through Academic Works as a one stop shop for students to find the scholarships available.
- Sadly only CSET and the College of Business entered their scholarships into Scholarship Finder. The other colleges kept their scholarships separately.
- Based the research conducted last January, over \$800,000 could have been spent on student scholarships over the last few years that went un-awarded. \$270,000 of those dollars were from last year alone.
- Currently, departments are spending discretionary department dollars (between \$8,000 and \$15,000 per department) on funding scholarships that no longer have institutional funding to back them up. \$61,000 was awarded last year from funds that were no longer available and had to come from discretionary department dollars.
- The foundation was not pleased at how much scholarship funding is being un-awarded.
- K Stanley states that all colleges needed to be involved in one universal scholarship process for students.
- K. Stanley's team met with SRCs to discuss what has and hasn't worked about the current process. All people involved were ASF members.
- For the new scholarship process, deans will select someone as scholarship champion in each college who will work with students and University Advancement to maximize scholarship dollars.
- K. Stanley would like to standardize the University scholarship deadlines. His plan is for January to be the month where colleges finalize all scholarships available for the next school year. The scholarships will then be marketed to students through posters, social media, D2L, advertising in Campus Newsletter. Students would then apply for scholarships in February. Faculty would then select scholarship winners in March. If a scholarship is not awarded by the end of March an Ad Hoc Committee will review the scholarship to see if the funding can be awarded to students who need the funding.
- S. Granberg-Rademacker asked if there is an assessment tool for the new process. K. Stanley answered that there has been one in place for the last four years, but that it was voluntary.
- Currently 2200 students went on scholarship finder this year, for an average of one time. K. Stanley's goal is to double this number. The universal timeline for scholarships is crucial for achieving this goal.
- J. Van Boxel asked what percentage of scholarships K. Stanley sees being awarded from faculty verses the Ad. Hoc committee. K. Stanley answered that this is currently unknown but he hopes that it will be a small number. He will know more after this year.
- R. Straka added that there will need to be coordination with financial aid office due to changes in student awards. Financial Aid Director T. Heu is aware of the new scholarship process and was present at the recent scholarship champions meeting. R. Straka added that when a student gets a scholarship it may mean a reallocation of aid with less student loans, and not necessarily more money available to the student.
- M. Wells explained that the scholarship process update is an institutional priority because overcoming financial barriers is a retention issue.

- R. Davenport added that nationwide, 20% of students who drop out of college could be saved if we could get ahead of their financial crises. Almost every institution is struggling to do this. The end of freshman year and senior year are when students are most likely to drop out due to finances, which is why scholarships are so critical.
- M. Wells gave context that various donor scholarship agreements have defined criteria. Faculty sometimes add additional elements, such as recommendation letters, to reduce applications. However, these additional barriers are not beneficial to students.
- M. Wells added that scholarship money is an honor that can be added to resume and not just a check. It is also a good way for students to build relationships with donors.

### E. Online Learning Solutions and Models (M. Wells)

- Handout provided.
- The system is moving forward with an online framework, so it is good that we are ahead of this.
- The proposed plan is about identifying best practices and models as well as defining market growth and new market segments.
- In November, M. Wells shared the current roster of online programs.
- External experts were brought in to give us the best knowledge currently available.
- Feedback was due by 12/7/17 for the framework for selecting programs to pilot the online learning solutions and models.
- S. Granberg-Rademacker stated that the feedback we received from our members was that the categories selected seemed relevant but that our membership expertise was not on recommending programs. Our members also voiced concerns for student support and how fees will be assessed. S. Granberg-Rademacker added that we won't get a lot of feedback from members until the project is further along and the impact becomes more apparent.
- The online work plan includes 8 areas with 38 goals, objectives, and action steps.
- The handout details the front line action team. Please let M. Wells know before the first meeting on January 8<sup>th</sup> if you feel there's someone else who should be on the frontline action team that was not listed.
- The frontline action team will meet every two weeks for the first two months and then once per month after that to keep on track.

### F. Website Update (C.Hughes)

- The website update is right on track with the schedule outlined.
- Dec. 8<sup>th</sup> marks the soft launch of the Office of the President's page. They expect minor problems that will be resolved quickly.
- The new homepage and other high level pages (links off of the homepage) will go live during the second half of January.
- There have been more than 150 people involved in developing effective website content. There has been good engagement from the campus while getting ready for the transition.
- Most other websites will be ready to go live by February or March.
- IT is currently working on training materials.
- IT is working with an outside implementation partner for the data from the online academic catalog that feeds into the website program day. This project will wrap up in April.
- R. Pinero asked if anyone can do the training or if it is just open to editors. C. Hughes answered that anyone can do the training, you do not have to be editor to attend the training.

- G. Strategic Budget Planning Update (R. Straka)
  - The teams are currently in place for scoring and have gone through training on how to look at the rubrics.
  - Scoring groups have been assigned as academic and non-academic.
  - The rubrics are due back for categorization in January. Individual program initial categorization will happen at that time so that programs have time to appeal.
  - The final categorization will be available to the general public in February and March after the appeal process concludes.
