Meeting Chair – President Davenport

I. Information Items

A. Review of Notes

- No changes noted. If changes are needed they can be recommended to the MSUAASF President.

B. MSU President's Report (R. Davenport)

- The employee appreciation breakfast will take place on Monday 5/7/18 from 8-9:30am in the University Dining Center.
- The annual President's Retreat has been tentatively set for Tuesday, August 14th.
- The convocation address has been scheduled for Monday, August 20th.
- Chancellor Malhotra is visiting Mankato today for an interview with the Free Press to help support the MN State appropriations request. Chancellor Malhotra is on a 10 city tour in 2 days.
- All Presidents with bonding projects will be at the MN House at 9:30am tomorrow. Since we are 3rd in the bonding projects and 4th on the list we stand a good chance of being funded.
- R. Davenport attended the I90 Legislative event yesterday with 125-150 legislators. R. Davenport spoke to many key legislators about the bonding project and they seemed confident that we would get funded. The only concern is if there is a large legislative battle at the end of the session and there is no bonding project this year.
- The Leadership Council meets next week. The Council is scheduled on our campus in June. R. Davenport is seeing how many people from campus he is able to invite to the event to meet with the Presidents.
- R. Davenport stated that we accomplished a lot this year. We set the boat in motion and have a good sense of direction.

C. MSUAASF President's Report (S. Granberg-Rademacker)

- We are almost at the end of the academic year. Our members are working on preparing programs and academic opportunities for next year and introducing new students to campus. This is a time of reflection and moving forward for our members.
- Our contract has been approved and is now at the legislature. It will be attached to a clean omnibus bill so it will hopefully be approved by the end of the session.
- Our contract has changed regarding contract release time and shared governance. S. Granberg-Rademacker thanks HR for helping to navigate this territory. HR and MSUAASF started talking about this change last summer. HR released a document on how to interpret shared governance and how it affects MSUAASF. This is unprecedented in the system and one less thing new MSUAASF leadership has to worry about in the fall.
- S. Granberg-Rademacker thanked R. Davenport, B. Fleischman, S. Barrett, and M. Wells for the excellent attendance for Dori Leland's FLSA presentation. S. Granberg-Rademacker appreciates Dori Leland's black and white delineation for what FLSA means and what it

doesn't. Dori Leland's presentation at Mankato was by far the best attended in the system. Our members were able to ask questions and gain clarification.

- S. Granberg-Rademacker thanked our executive team members who won't be at the table next year for their service this year: J. Clarke, K. Seth, R. Wheeler, R. Pinero, O. Gonzalez.
- R. Davenport seconds the accolades to the executive team this year.
- S. Granberg-Rademacker announced the new executive team for the 2018-2019 academic year: J. Van Boxel, M. Iverson, M. Slotemaker, R. Tanquist, C. Nelson.
- Our membership approved constitutional changes for staggered MSUAAASF leadership to provide more continuous service to our members and leadership.
- ASF contract negotiation starts again in 6 months.

D. Vice President Student Affairs & Enrollment Management Report (D. Jones)

- Summer enrollment down is 3% or 32 FYE. This is not surprising since enrollment was down for spring.
- Fall enrollment is up 1.8% in overall applications. There is a .5% decline in overall undergraduate applications due to the decrease in international applications. Graduate applications are up 23%. Intent to enroll is up 11% compared to next year.
- We are up 16 FYE for continuing student fall enrollment compared to last year.
- R. Davenport asked if we currently have information on concurrent enrollment. D. Jones says that we do not but we do have more high schools that we are contracting with for this fall compared to last fall.
- S. Granberg-Rademacker asked if that data gives us a good sense of retention. D. Jones answered yes. D. Jones stated that for current students who are not yet registered (but are eligible to return) we text them, call via our call center, and send a postcard in the summer. D. Jones also stated that the 10th day of classes is a better date to determine retention from last year.
- S. Granberg-Rademacker also asked what the context is for being 16 students up. D. Jones answered that for calculation purposes 15 credits=1 FYE. Since our registration windows are different than last year due to a later fall start it is a good sign we have positive retention numbers.
- J. Van Boxel asked if it shows positive retention since the spring term is a smaller overall class and we are still up 16 FYE. D. Jones answered yes.
- M. Iverson asked about orientation and housing numbers. D. Jones answered that orientations are approximately 16% up. They have expanded orientation seats to accommodate.
- J. Clarke stated that Learning Communities are up as well.

II. Discussion Items

A. Budget (R.Straka)

- The Strategic Budget Plan results were emailed out today. The email reviewed the process and gave links to see the final categorizations.
- There were 370 programs involved, 311 of which were academic. These categorizations will be important as we look at next fall and the work we have to do to balance the budget.
- In 2019, R. Straka is projecting a 2 million dollar structural deficit, 3 million when tuition is factored in.
- We do have a salary savings with vacancies and failed probationary searches of around a million dollars to build into the budget.
- R. Straka plans on using the Strategic Budget Plan results as a piece of plan along with other strategic and academic plans to see what we need to do to meet the deficit next year as well as where we can make investments (reallocations).
- For context we have a \$150 million budget so our deficit is only 1.5% of the overall budget. We are still funded for 98-99% of what we do.
- Cash flow wise this year very good year. Inflation from year to year was less than expected. There was a positive cash flow and we can reserve 2 million to help settle next year.

- R. Davenport's meeting today is to support the full proposal from the board of trustees and the chancellor.

B. HR Topics (S. Barrett)

- Human Resource Vacancies
 - S. Granberg-Rademacker found some inaccuracies on the fixed term list. S. Barrett will send an updated list today.
 - The vacancies list show where we are in the search process and by bargaining unit. We currently have a 3% vacancy rate. This is slightly higher than state overall but we're in the ballpark. Our vacancy rate is always higher this time of year.
 - If you have any questions regarding the vacancy list please send an email to S. Barrett.
- Human Resources Investigation Process
 - There are 18 total complaints with an additional 1 that arrived this morning.
 - The new process is running smoothly. The investigations are starting earlier and completed in a timely manner. HR is currently just under 30 day goal and their goal is to finish the academic year in June with similar numbers.
 - It is harder for HR to schedule interviews in summer due to people being off campus. S. Barrett hopes this doesn't skew the average too much.
 - S. Barrett will put together a year-end report by bargaining unit. There are not a lot of ASF investigations.
- FLSA, May 2 Expert Visit
 - Very well attended sessions with Dori Leland and Jim Jorstad. There were a lot of good questions and guidance for people affected by FLSA.
 - One of the questions that came up was hiring hourly staff as adjunct professors. A number of our adjunct professors are already hourly employees. S. Barrett advises departments to hire the best adjuncts we can get and to not base decisions on overtime eligibility.
 - S. Barrett was unable to attend the morning session. J. Van Boxel and S. Granberg-Rademacker attended and said it was good.
 - S. Granberg-Rademacker stated that individuals in both sessions asked for clarification on who decides whether overtime is paid time or comp time. The MSUAASF contact states that supervisors and employees should come to a mutual agreement, but if no agreement is met, the MSUAASF employee chooses.
 - S. Barrett stated that he is not sure if a lot of overtime expenses have been accrued since ASF positions transitioned to hourly.
 - J. Clarke stated that it has been challenging transitioning to overtime. She gave the example of paying attention to if you answer the phone at your desk during your lunch break and then having to count that as work time. It is challenging for staff to put down that they worked overtime even though they should because we've never had to before.
 - S. Barrett answered that this is part of the transition that will take time.
 - H. Morris asked if once an employee decides on comp time versus overtime if it can be reversed. S. Barrett originally answered that it can't unless they leave the University. R. Straka stated that depending on the contract, employees have the discretion to cash out comp time for paid overtime. The ASF contract also specifies how much comp time can be accrued before it must be paid as overtime.
 - S. Barrett stated that it is helpful that J. Van Boxel is doing his doctoral dissertation on FLSA.
 - J. Clarke added that it is important for supervisors and employees to know that it is okay if things don't get done on the timeline that they used to. Supervisors must be held accountable if they reprimand employees for not being able to accomplish what they used to in 60 hours when employees are now limited to 40 hours. R.

Wheeler added that if they keep the same expectations they must pay overtime for it now.

- S. Barrett stated that some departments, such as Residential Life, will need to re-organize things and set reasonable expectations for what to expect.
- J. Van Boxel stated that there are two areas to look at in the next year. The first is if there is pressure to change position descriptions. The second is to see whether employees are evaluated differently now that they are considered hourly.
- Members have expressed concern that they are being evaluated poorly because they can't accomplish what they used to without overtime.
- R. Davenport asked S. Barrett how long the remaining positions will take to be reviewed. S. Barrett thinks they will all come back this summer.
- H. Morris stated that no one should be working 60 hours every week and that it should always have been peak times and non-peak times. The balancing act with FLSA is the problem now since we are limited to pay periods instead of the whole academic year.
- J. Clarke stated that for our members non-peak time is when we accomplished items on our to-do lists that have been put off for years and may now not ever get accomplished.
- R. Straka stated that this is similar to a change in facilities staff a few years ago where expectations had to be reduced on the time projects would take. Some services also had to be eliminated such as hanging up items in offices.
- R. Straka stated that we will have to adjust and possibly make future budget changes and allocation decisions for overtime and comp time or more positions may have to be created.
- S. Barrett will keep us involved as positions come back from the system office.
- R. Davenport recommended holding a supervisor orientation training to head off grievances from staff who are being penalized for now having to get all of their work done within 40 hours. Supervisors ordinarily expected will take longer and need to work with the staff to make sure everything is accomplished. Don't need to back up HR with unnecessary complaints. S. Barrett says he can put that together.

- Anna Maravelas Follow-Up

- The video of the afternoon session is now posted. The link went out to staff today and will be available for one month for staff who could not attend the session.
- The issues addressed are not a one talk thing. There will be future discussions in the fall of where we go from here to maintain and build a respectful workplace environment. This talk was meant to spur discussion and ideas for how to make our workplace the best it can be.
- S. Granberg-Rademacker heard Anna Maravelas speak before at the Leadership Institute. S. Granberg-Rademacker appreciates that she was brought on campus and hopes that individuals we wished were in the audience are able to hear the message.
- J. Van Boxel added that a message he hopes we build on in the fall is how to be more civil to others and how to manage situations where we don't have the organizational power to give people more control over a situation that they may not think they have.
- S. Barrett was pleased that many people attended.
- R. Straka added that his staff really liked the presentation. He and his staff discussed the importance of dealing with and recognizing emotional and physical reactions to situations. R. Straka stated that this training was very helpful and as a supervisor it was very appreciated. R. Straka is encouraging his staff members who weren't able to attend to watch the video.

- Staffing Process

- An HR team was created to work on staffing processes and how we can improve them.

- The length of time to hire is standing out as an area to improve. ASF and faculty positions take around 160 days to fill. Classified positions take an average of 80 days. This is a long process.
- This is an open discussion for how to make improvements and get the best people we can. As an organization we want to reach people and make offers sooner than anyone else to get the best faculty and staff since we are competing nationally and with system colleagues.
- There will be more data to compile and share in the fall. S. Barrett would like to see if there is a correlation between a failed search and the length of time the search takes. S. Barrett would also like to see how many qualified candidates drop out during a search.
- S. Barrett plans on reviewing the last 2.5 years of staffing and recruiting data to get a baseline of where our hiring timeline is currently at to then make a plan of where we got from here. He plans to hit the ground running with the plan in September.
- S. Granberg-Rademacker asked what an ideal hiring timeline would be. S. Barrett answered that it is a balancing process that identifies the best of the best but in a timely fashion to get offers sooner. S. Barrett believes that it should be shorter than it is now but that he does not have a specific answer for faculty positions yet. For classified positions, in his experience it should not take more than 30 days.

C. Legislative Update (R. Straka)

- The governor recommended 10 million dollars for the 2019 fiscal year and ISRS NextGen. The House and the Senate proposed significantly less funding than that. There will likely not be much funding for the fiscal year and maybe some funding for NextGen.
- J. Clarke added that our state ASF recommended members to contact our legislators regarding funding NextGen to let them know what it means to our daily work when ISRS crashes. Underfunding NextGen is detrimental to our daily work and student success.
- R. Davenport added that the President's Office sent out letters to all legislators. D. Malhotra is doing a press tour regarding this and getting the Presidents involved.
- D. Malhotra and R. Davenport will be talking with the Free Press tonight about our funding needs and the bonding project during the 30 minute interview.
- There is currently a political battle between the legislature and the governor regarding the DMV that may affect the legislative climate.

D. Essential Employees and Campus Closed Announcements (MSUAASF)

- MSUAASF brought this topic to the table to continue the conversation from our February Meet and Confer.
- Since weather essential employees are notified at the beginning of the academic year this is a good time to clarify our policy and procedures before that occurs.
- It is important to clarify who is weather essential and what that communication means in regards to working from home or the right to take vacation.
- Students and families dealt with misinformation at the last closing (ex. My kid can't eat in the dining hall) so we are hoping to reduce that misinformation in the future.
- J. Van Boxel stated that there are two important challenges to discuss. The first is it's important to recognize that there is a drop in services because there is not enough staffing to clear parking lots and accessibility stalls have been blocked by snow. There also was not enough staff to clear doorways. There is no clear solution to this. The second is that we need to add more context to the Campus Closed legal term since families take it literally and we want to reduce stress for parents who assume their student will not be able to stay in the dorms or eat.
- R. Davenport acknowledges that closing the campus is a difficult decision to make since we are a residential campus. K-12 schools and Community Colleges have an easier time. B. Fleischman communicates with R. Davenport regarding the weather at all times day or night to keep him updated on the status of the roads and weather.

- B. Fleischman stated that whether busses are running or not is a major consideration to if we close. We have to balance the needs of the students in residence vs. those who have to commute to campus. Roads are another factor and if Paul Corcoran's crew can keep up with the snow.
- These conversations often go through the night. J. Van Boxel says that our board understands those concerns. We understand that it is a tough call and that there is not a lot of complaining or second guessing.
- R. Straka added that AFSCME staff have raised the concern that someone who lives three blocks away is always required to come to work whereas someone who lives farther away is not required to come in because they can't travel. There is not a perfect solution because both sides' concerns are valid.
- B. Fleischman stated that Paul Corcoran's crew does a great job of getting ahead of the snow. The executive team tries to coordinate closures so that the information will run on the 10pm news instead of waiting until the 4am newscast as the procedures require.
- R. Straka adds that we can control the messaging on our website, emails, star alerts, etc. but we can't control the media's messaging.
- Our Normandale class cancelled decisions are easier because we can base them on what Normandale College is doing. The 7700 building is also an independent decision so there are 3 separate closure decisions that need to be made. M. Wells added that individual faculty members can make independent decisions regarding their own classes. Just because one class is cancelled does not necessarily mean that the rest will be.
- R. Straka stated that we can beef up our Star Alert message to clarify what Campus Closed means.
- R. Davenport stated that we haven't solved the Campus Closed dilemma but we will continue to discuss solutions.
